


Australian growing regions








Estimated % of plantings@ ages

Australian processing sector

There are 7 major processors, 2 smaller processors and 2 inshell handlers (http://www.australian-macadamias.org/trade/suppliers) in Australia that together process over 90% of the Australian crop. These processor currently have the capacity to process the entire Australian crop as kernel if required.


All Australian processors are HACCP accredited as well as many other relevant global food safety certifications.




World class quality control

A strong united industry

The AMS is the only representative body for macadamias in Australia.

It was established over 40 years ago

The Society covers all sectors of the industry including growers, processors, input suppliers, researchers, service providers and value adders

It has 750 members of which around 650 are growers

Our members account for around 85% of production

The Society manages the industry communications and marketing programs and supports R&D with a comprehensive extension program.



Through this mechanism the Australian industry spends around A\$2.5 million annually on research and close to A\$3 million on marketing


